Does Angola have a solar power plant?

In early June, the Export-Import Bank of the United States awarded a loan to Angola's Ministry of Energy and Water to deploy two large-scale solar power plants, totaling 500 MW. According to the latest statistics from the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Angola had 297 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2022.

What is Sun Africa doing in Angola?

Serving as its second large-scale solar project in the country, Miami-based utility-scale solar project developer, Sun Africa, will deploy 728 MW of solar photovoltaic mini-grids with battery storage and home power kits, which will support the electrification of more than two million people in four southern Angolan provinces.
