Does the EU impose a dumping duty on solar panels?

the imposition of measures is not against the Union interest. On the basis of these findings, it has been decided to impose an anti-dumping dutyin a two-staged process: for two months, a duty of 11.8% will have to be paid, whereas from 6 August, duties ranging from 37.3% to 67.9% (averaging 47.6%) will be levied on solar panels from China.

Will European Commission impose anti-dumping duties on Chinese solar panels?

The European Commission today decided to impose provisional anti-dumping dutieson imports of solar panels and key components (i.e. cells and wafers) from China. An investigation found that a Chinese solar panel is sold to Europe far below its normal market value.

How long are anti-dumping duties imposed on solar panels?

Provisional anti-dumping duties are imposed for a six monthsperiod. The 11.8% duty enters into force on 6 June at midnight and one minute local time, i.e. the anti-dumping duty is applied on solar panel imports one hour later in Dover than for example at the port of Rotterdam.

Are Chinese solar panels being dumped in the EU?

The investigation was initiated on 6 September 2012 following a complaint lodged by EU ProSun, an industry association, which claims solar panels from China are being dumped in the EUat prices below market value and causing material injury to the EU photovoltaic industry (MEMO/12/647).

Does the EU 'double-anti' policy affect China's PV industry?

The results of the research showed that China has not yet formed a complete value chain of the PV industry that is internationally competitive. The economic effect of the "double-anti" policy on China as a result of the EU is more pronounced than that with the U.S.

Are Chinese solar modules flooding the EU market?

Industry data suggests that solar modules from China sold for 50 % of their production cost are flooding the EU market. While this influx can help the deployment of solar power in Europe in the short term, imports at dumped costs open the door to products benefiting from unfair market and labour conditions.
