Argentina has some of the world's best renewable energy potential, but financing the opportunity to explore it has been challenging. In early 2016, the Government of Argentina launched the RenovAr initiative. It is an auction-based renewable energy program designed to scale-up private renewable generation capacity.

In search of solutions to growing shortages, the government seized on Argentina's still largely untapped, but potentially vast renewable energy sector and created an ambitious program called RenovAr (renew in Spanish). By 2016, the country's share of renewable energy stood at less than 2 percent of the power mix.
