What is the government of the Kingdom of Eswatini?

Government of the Kingdom of Eswatini is the union government created by the constitution of Eswatini where the monarch holds supreme executive, legislative, and judicial powers. The Ngwenyama (lion) is a hereditary leader, rules the country, with the assistance of a council of ministers and a national legislature.

Is Eswatini a country?

Eswatini (/ˈeswɑːˈtiːni / (i) ESS-wah-TEE-nee; Swazi: eSwatini [eswáˈtʰiːni]), formally the Kingdom of Eswatini and also known by its former official name Swaziland (/ˈswɑːˈzɪlænd / (i) SWAH-zee-land) and formerly the Kingdom of Swaziland, [11] [12] is a landlocked country in Southern Africa.

What does Eswatini stand for?

In April 2018, the official name was changed from Kingdom of Swaziland to Kingdom of Eswatini, mirroring the name commonly used in Swazi. [12] [16] [17] Eswatini is a developing country that is classified as having a lower-middle income economy.

How is the Eswatini government appointed?

The cabinet of the Eswatini government is appointed by the king on advice from the prime minister. The members of the cabinet must be members of either Houses of parliament. The members of the cabinet are known as ministers, and they head government departments called ministries.
