Bhutan is exploring photovoltaic (PV) solar energy development to enhance its energy system's overall resilience. To ensure efficient grid planning and solar integration, Bhutan's power generator, Druk Green Power Corporation, and the transmission and distribution utility, Bhutan Power Corporation, are partnering

Tata Power has joined forces with Druk Green Power Corp. to develop 5,000 MW of clean energy capacity in Bhutan. This includes large-scale hydropower and solar projects aimed at supporting Bhutan's energy goals and regional integration.

The partnership is in line with Bhutan's vision to expand its total energy generation capacity to 25,000 MW by 2040. Bhutan aims to achieve this goal by diversifying its energy portfolio beyond traditional hydropower to include solar and geothermal energy while exploring innovative project structures and financing through strategic partnerships.

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has provided over \$18 million in grants and loans to support the project, with an additional \$1 million from the Government of Bhutan. This initiative will contribute 17 megawatts of clean energy to Bhutan's power grid, bringing the country closer to achieving full energy independence.
