Should students have access to locker rooms?

All students should have access to locker rooms, bathrooms, and shower facilities that are safe, comfortable, and convenient. Absent a concern for safety, schools should permit a student to use the restrooms or locker rooms for which they identify.

Can a school have a restroom & locker room?

A school in California may maintain separate restroom and locker room facilities for male and female students. However, students shall have access to the restroom and locker room that corresponds to their gender identity asserted at school.

What should I do if I have a locker in the shower?

Short answer is this: when in doubt, ask management. A longer answer includes some general principles: Use your locker to store clothes, and anything you don't want in the shower with you. Lock your locker and take the key with you (if it's not a combination lock). Wear a towel around your waist going from the locker to the shower.
