Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

Can solar panels be built without permission?

This is because they generally fall under permitted development rights, which allow homeowners to make reasonably sized changes without getting permission. The exceptions to this rule are typically flats, listed buildings, homes in conservation areas, and ground-mounted installations. What are the building regulations for solar panels?

Do solar panels need planning permission?

Typically, solar panel installations in the UK are considered "permitted developments" and do not require planning permission, as long as they meet certain conditions. However, permissions are necessary if the building is listed or in a conservation area. What is MCS certification and why is it important for solar panel installation?

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Are solar PV installations notifiable?

To clarify, what is certain is that nearly all domestic electrical work is notifiable under Part P of the Building Regulations (see below) and a solar PV installation is nearly always notifiable electrical work.

Do you own solar panels?

You OWN the solar panels. Under these schemes, you pay for solar panels over a fixed period, say 20 years. There are no upfront costs, and instead you pay a monthly fee, which usually covers the solar panel and battery installation, repairs and maintenance.
