Can you spray paint lockers?

We ended up using 6 of these cans to give these metal lockers a thick white coat. I always use the spray paint comfort grip because it seriously saves your thumb when using spray paint cans. You could also do this project with a paint sprayer if you had one on hand.

Can you paint a locker with Rust Oleum paint?

If you are able to paint outdoors in temperatures above 50 degrees Fahrenheit, I recommend using spray paint instead to get the best finish on your lockers. Step 6: Paint over the primer with a durable paint such as Rust-Oleum Painter's Touch Ultra Cover paint.

Can you paint a locker with white paint?

If you do the white first, you don't need to tape.) Cover the doors and tape the edges before spraying the inside of the lockers black. Be sure to cover the holes on the sides of the lockers with tape so that the black does not come through the holes and create shadows on the white paint.

Just fill the paint container with paint (may need to thin it with water), hook the hose to the paint gun and base, plug it in and go to town. How do you remove black paint from lockers?

Be sure to cover the holes on the sides of the lockers with tape so that the black does not come through the holes and create shadows on the white paint. If you find that you need to touch up the white paint after you have already sprayed the black paint, masking paper works great to prevent overspray.
