When did Chow Yun-fat become a movie star?

The emotional role awarded Chow Yun-fat with Best Actor at the 1987 Hong Kong Film Awards, and he went on to star in two more sequels for A Better Tomorrow. The second film in director Ringo Lam's On Fire trilogy, Prison on Fire kickstarted a trend of Hong Kong-made prison films that lasted well into the early 1990s.

Is Chow Yun fat a good movie?

Chow Yun Fat delivers a powerful performance as the conflicted Nick Chen, who is torn between his duty to uphold the law and his loyalty to his community. Mark Wahlberg also shines as the idealistic Danny Wallace, who must navigate the complex web of corruption and violence that surrounds him.

Those are followed up with more Fresh Hong Kong action epics like Hard-Boiled, City on Fire, and Full Contact. Yun-fat broke into Hollywood shortly afterwards with late-'90s crime films like The Replacement Killers and The Corruptor, the unfortunate Dragonball: Evolution, and culminating in Pirates of the Caribbean: At World's End.
