How do I get to Bonaire & Sint Eustatius?

Reaching Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, and Saba usually starts with a flight to one of the larger neighboring islands, such as St. Maarten, before taking a smaller regional aircraft into the islands' respective airports: Flamingo International Airport in Bonaire, F.D. Roosevelt Airport in Sint Eustatius, and Juancho E. Yrausquin Airport in Saba.

Where are Sint Eustatius & Saba?

Sint Eustatius and Saba are in the main Lesser Antilles group, south of Sint Maarten (a constituent country of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, along with Curacao and Aruba.). Saba and Sint Eustatius are also (there is some debate about this) part of the Windward Islands and are volcanic and hilly, with little ground suitable for agriculture.

The Caribbean Netherlands comprises three islands - Bonaire, Saba, and St. Eustatius - in the southern Caribbean Sea. As integral components of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, these islands provide distinct experiences and attractions due to their varied landscapes and dynamic communities.
