Amea Power has secured a power purchase agreement (PPA) for a 25 MW solar-plus-storage projectin Djibouti. It will be the country's first independent power producer (IPP) project and is now in development under a build-own-operate and transfer (BOOT) framework.

### What is the cost of electricity in Djibouti?

The cost of electricity in Djibouti is 23.4 US cents per kWh(in 2017). This is higher than the costs in Ethiopia, which were 4.7 and 4.4 US cents/kwh in 2016 and 2017, respectively.

#### Who will take over Djibouti energy project?
