Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

How to install solar panels?

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels?

Homeowners with flat roofs used to need planning permission install solar panels, but in December 2023 the government changed its 'permitted development' rules. This made it easier for more homes to have solar panels, including those with flat roofs.

Can solar PV systems be installed on a pitched roof?

The guidelines also say that provision must be made for ventilation behind the solar PV modules to provide cooling. With the introduction of MCS012 in March 2012 we would now expect all MCS certified installers of solar PV systems to install solar PV systems on pitched roofs using only MCS012 certified roof fixings.

Should solar panels be installed on a north-facing roof?

In the southern hemisphere, it's ideal to install solar panels on north-facing roofs because that's where they get the most sunlight. If you live in the northern hemisphere, you should install your solar panels facing south. But what if your roof faces the wrong direction? If your roof faces east or west, solar panels are still a viable option.

Do you need a professional to install solar panels?

Despite being intricate bits of kit that can generate electricity from the sun, solar panels are pretty straightforwardfor a professional to set up. Before an installer is able to crack on with the actual installation, a professional surveyor will need to go into your loft and check the integrity of both the roof and the rafters.
