What is the French Southern Territories nature reserve?

In 2006, the French Southern Territories Nature Reserve was created around the Crozet archipelago and the Kerguelen, Saint-Paul and Amsterdam islands. This reserve, which by 2022 will cover an area of 1.6 million km<sup>2</sup>, is one of the largest marine protected areas in the world and has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2019.
