What is WeChat Pay?

Also known as Weixin Pay, WeChat Pay is a mobile payment system and digital wallet service that enables WeChat users to make payments directly through the app. WeChat Pay supports several payment flows, including QR code, in-app, Mini Program, and Official Account payments.

How many countries is WeChat Pay open to?

WeChat Pay is open to 49 countries (regions). All the methods of WeChat Cross-Border Pay are the same as WeChat Pay, including Quick Pay, QR Code Payment, In-App Payment and In-App Web-based Payment. Vendors scan the QR Code shown by customers on the Quick Pay page to finish transactions quickly. This method applies to offline payment scenarios.

How does WeChat work?

Merchants scan the code to take the payment. Users open WeChat to scan the code, confirm the amount, and make the payment after passing the security checks. Users pay for goods or services in Mini Programs created inside WeChat. Users can pay for goods and services inside the merchant's Official Account.

How to pay with WeChat Pay in China?

Here are two ways you can pay with WeChat Pay in China: Scan the QR code provided by the merchant or by entering their WeChat ID. Upon successful completion, you'll receive a notification confirming the transaction. Utilise Quick Pay and have your QR code ready for the vendor to scan.

Does WeChat Pay support recurring payments?

Merchants can currently use WeChat Pay to support 26 settlement currencies, including US dollars, Euros, and British pounds. WeChat Pay merchants are expected to display the WeChat Pay logo for their customers to see. Although WeChat Pay supports several different payment flows, it doesn't currently process customer recurring payments.

Is WeChat Pay better than other mobile payment systems?

WeChat has nearly 1.3 billion monthly active users, making it the second largest mobile payment giant after Alipay, and WeChat Pay accounts for 39.53% of China's mobile payment market share.
