How much money does Libya make a year?

Libya earns around \$20 billion per year in net revenues from oil and gas exports, which accounts for around 95 percent of state revenue. Much of this wealth pays for a bloated public sector that employs almost one third of the population, as well as for state subsidies meant to guarantee low prices for fuel and, until recently, basic foodstuffs.

What's behind Libya's cost of living crisis & foreign cash crunch?

The cost of living crisis and foreign cash crunch come after the Central Bank of Libya announced steps it said were aimed at ensuring greater financial stability. It restricted import letters of credit -- the only legal means for an importer to buy products in foreign currencies -- to the purchase abroad of medicines and food products.

What is the price of electricity in Libya?

Libya, September 2022: The price of electricity is 0.011 U.S. Dollar per kWh for households and 0.042 U.S. Dollar for businesses which includes all components of the electricity bill such as the cost of power, distribution and taxes.

What's happening with Libya's currency?

Libya's dinar currency -- which officially trades at 4.8 to the US dollar -- has recently dropped on the parallel market from around five dinar to the greenback to 7.5 now.
