The British Indian Ocean Territory (Constitution) Order 2004 defines the territory as comprising the following islands or groups of islands: These islands and associated coral reefs lie between 4°44 and 7°41 south and 70°47 and 72°47 east.

How many islands are in the British Indian Ocean territory?

The British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) is an Overseas Territory of the United Kingdom situated in the Indian Ocean, halfway between Tanzania and Indonesia. The territory comprises the seven atolls of the Chagos Archipelago with over 1,000 individual islands, many very small, amounting to a total land area of 60 square kilometres (23 square ...

The micro combined heat and power (micro-CHP), or cogeneration, units produce simultaneously decentralized heat and power from a single fuel source at high efficiency. The building integrated micro-cogeneration systems are in the key role in reaching the primary energy and pollutant emissions reduction targets of the EU [2].

By integrating large numbers of micro-chp, solar cells and wind turbines and possibly also consuming appliances such as heat pumps and electric vehicles via an information and communication system, a so-called Smart Power System or virtual plant can be created.
