Namibia will have a new wind farm within a few months. This is the aim of the agreements recently signed between NamPower, the state-owned electricity company, and Cerim Lüderitz Energy, a joint venture between the giant China Energy Engineering Corporation (CEEC) and the Namibian company Riminii Investments.

The proposed wind power plant will be built for 1.4 billion Namibian dollars (\$96.4 million) and is expected to be ready within 27 months. The commercial operation is expected by July 2025, China's Xinhua News Agency reported, citing NamPower's statement.

NamPower is set to enter into a Power Purchase Agreement, and a Transmission Connection Agreement with the China Energy International Group, Riminii Investments Joint Venture, for the development and connection of the 50MW Wind Power Plant to the Namibian transmission grid.
