

How does a wind generator work?

The energy in the wind turns the blades that are connected to the main shaft, which turns and spins a second shaft, which spins a generator to create electricity. - A machine that is used to make electricity. When the generator head is turned, this energy is converted to electrical energy.

## What is a wind turbine generator?

What is a wind turbine? A wind turbine, or wind generator or wind turbine generator, is a device that converts the kinetic energy of wind (a natural and renewable source) into electricity. Whereas a ventilator or fan uses electricity to create wind, a wind turbine does the opposite: it harnesses the wind to make electricity.

Kinetic energy from the moving air is transferred to the spinning blades. The blades turn a shaft which is connected to a gearbox.

# Do wind turbines produce electricity?

The turbines do not actually produce wind energy, directly. The blades turn, convert the energy of wind into rotational energy, a form of mechanical energy, and this energy is in turn converted into electrical energy. Horizontal-axis wind turbines (HAWTs) are the most familiar type of electricity-producing windmill.
