Do solar panels comply with building regulations?

Your solar panel system must comply with building regulations in terms of structural integrity, electrical safety and fire safety. These regulations may vary depending on the size and type of the installation. It's advisable to work with accredited installers who are familiar with these requirements.

When did solar panels become a building regulation?

In 2005, household electrical work was absorbed into the UK government's official Building Regulations. A year later, the Climate Change and Sustainable Energy Act 2006 brought microgeneration systems like solar panels under the umbrella of the Building Regulations. What is considered a stand-alone solar PV installation?

What are the requirements for solar panel installation?

Immediate enforcement action by HSE inspectors. Solar panel installation is not short duration work and will need scaffolding or similar equipment. It should have a boarded working platform and full edge protection (double guard-rails and toe-boards) to stop people and tools from falling. Debris netting may also be necessary to prevent materials

Can solar panels be built without permission?

This is because they generally fall under permitted development rights, which allow homeowners to make reasonably sized changes without getting permission. The exceptions to this rule are typically flats, listed buildings, homes in conservation areas, and ground-mounted installations. What are the building regulations for solar panels?
