What are the cheapest types of solar panels?

Polycrystalline solar panels and thin-film solar panels are the least expensive types of solar panels, typically costing around 20% less than monocrystalline panels. However, they are also less efficient.

Are cheap solar panels better than expensive solar panels?

Because cheap solar panels are, as a general rule, less efficient than more expensive varieties, you'll require more of them to generate the same amount of power as a more efficient, similarly sized solar system would.

Are cheap solar panels a good investment?

Cons of cheap solar panels: Lower efficiency: Cheap solar panels are more likely to be less efficient, usually around 18-21% efficient rather than 20-23% efficient. Affordability hurdle: The upfront cost of solar panels, even cheap ones, is still a significant investment that may only be affordable for some homeowners.

Are low-cost solar panels worth it?

Low-cost solar panels can be a cost-effective entry point for homeowners with lower electricity needs, particularly for a 4kW solar system or even a 5kW solar system, which is suitable for powering a 2-3 bedroom house.
