

What is Sina Weibo?

Is Weibo a networked public?

Weibo as "networked publics"--both a public space and collectives (boyd,2010)--have amplified the visibility and social impact of public events,and enabled individuals to gather on this public "square" to participate.

Did Weibo polarize social media?

However,the split of "Chinese characteristics" and "universal values" did capture the polarization of networked publics with escalated contentions and the party-state's more aggressive taking over of social media. Weibo enhanced public visibility of both sides of the ideological contention("universal values" versus "Chinese characteristics").

How popular is Weibo in China?

Of those who are active on the Internet in China,about one-third (or 212 million) were active on Weibo,which represented an increase of 48% in social media usage compared to a year ago (CNNIC,2015),making it one of the most visitedonline destinations in China (Alexa,2016).

Do Weibo opinion leaders reinforce the community's attitudes about the Tianjin explosion?

Integrating the findings from this study,the data suggest that Weibo opinion leaders most frequentlyreinforced the community's attitudes toward and opinions about the Tianjin explosion,contributing to the spread of opinion convergence on Weibo.

Do the Weibo Community see opinion leaders' tweets?

Since the data are collected based on the same keyword and hashtag and based on representativeness heuristics, this study made the assumption that the Weibo community sampled in this study have seen the tweets by the opinion leaders.
