Where are the solar power plants located in the Seychelles?

The facilities include the 5 MW solar PV plant located in Ile de Romainville, a 3.3 MWh energy storage system located on Mahé, and a 33kV system that allows for the safe and stable supply of electricity from the PV power plant to the main island of Mahé which, further, increases the resilience of the national grid of the Seychelles.

What is the energy storage system in the Seychelles?

The project includes an energy storage system with a capacity of 5MW and 3.3 megawatt-hours(MWh), allowing for the safe and stable supply of electricity from the PV power plant to the main island of Mahé and further increasing the resilience of the national grid of the Seychelles.

Who financed the Seychelles wind turbine project?

The project was financed by Abu Dhabi Fund for Development (ADFD), and is being developed by Masdar and the Seychelles' Public Utilities Corporation (PUC). The PV array is specifically designed to maximise the use of available land, while allowing for maintenance of the wind turbines and minimising any shading losses resulting from them.

Does the Seychelles use fossil fuels?

The Seychelles currently relies on fossil fuels, which account for around 20 percent of its imports, to meet its electricity demand. It is estimated the Ile de Romainville solar project will save approximately 2 million liters of fuel annually.

The Republic of Seychelles moved a step closer to realizing its clean energy ambitions with the inauguration of a UAE-funded 5-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic (PV) plant with battery storage, the second clean-energy project in the African island nation.

The project in the lagoon of Providence on Mahe island will create the country's first independent power producer (IPP) plant and will be the East African nation's first utility-scale floating photovoltaic (PV) system. French renewable power producer Qair won a tender to install the plant in 2018.

Abu Dhabi renewable energy company Masdar will build a 5-MW solar photovoltaic (PV) power plant with a 5-MW/3.3-MWh energy storage system in the Republic of Seychelles. The project is funded with a AED-31-million (USD 8.4m/EUR 7.3m) loan from Abu Dhabi Fund for Development (ADFD) and equity from the local Public Utilities Corporation (PUC).

Under the PPA, Qair will develop, build and operate on the lagoon of Providence a 5.8 MWp floating solar plant to supply renewable energy to the Seychelles grid. The construction is scheduled to start in the fourth quarter of 2023.
