What is a 2KW solar panel system?

The basics: let's look at what a 2kW PV Solar Panel System is. A 2kW solar PV system is smaller than most domestic and commercial solar arrays. When people talk about solar power, you'll often see a number, in this case 2, followed by the letters kW. This refers to how much potential power the system can produce. The letters stand for Kilowatts.

A 1 kW solar panel system is considered on the smaller size, with these systems typically being used for DIY projects, RVs, boats, vehicles, or off grid solar panels for small structures. The most commonly stated amount of electricity that these systems can produce is 850 kW per annum, or 2.3 kWh per day.

How many kilowatts does a home solar system produce?

A typical home might need 2,700kWh of electricity over a year - of course, not all these are needed during daylight hours.
