What if Australia's solar project collapsed?

"Although the costs have increased there is likely still value in the project," he said. He estimated that a full collapse of the solar project would result in a loss of export earnings for Australia's renewable energy sector of about US\$12bn a year. Forrest, who founded iron ore business Fortescue, declined to comment.

What happened to solar power in California?

That triggered multiple inverters to disconnect or momentarily stop injecting power into the grid, leading to the loss of nearly 1,200 megawatts of solar power, the first documented widespread tripping incident in the U.S. More than half of the affected resources in the California event returned to normal output within about five minutes.

What happened to solar power in West Texas?

May 9th of last year was supposed to be a typical day for solar power in west Texas. But around 11:21 a.m., something went wrong. Large amounts of solar capacity unexpectedly went offline, apparently triggered by a fault on the grid linked to a natural gas plant in Odessa, according to the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT).

How many solar panels have been cancelled in 2023?

Between June 2023 and February 2024, at least eightcompanies cancelled or suspended more than 59 GW of new production capacity, equivalent to 6.9% of China's total finished panel production capacity in 2023, according to the China Photovoltaic Industry Association.
