What is WeChat Pay?

Also known as Weixin Pay, WeChat Pay is a mobile payment system and digital wallet service that enables WeChat users to make payments directly through the app. WeChat Pay supports several payment flows, including QR code, in-app, Mini Program, and Official Account payments.

What is WeChat Pay (Weixin pay)?

WeChat Pay, officially referred to as Weixin Pay (Chinese: 微信支付; pinyin: Weixin Zhifù) in China, is a mobile payment and digital wallet service by WeChat based in China that allows users to make mobile payments and online transactions. As of March 2016, WeChat Pay had over 300 million users.

How to pay with WeChat Pay in China?

Here are two ways you can pay with WeChat Pay in China: Scan the QR code provided by the merchant or by entering their WeChat ID. Upon successful completion, you'll receive a notification confirming the transaction. Utilise Quick Pay and have your QR code ready for the vendor to scan.

What are Chinese payment platforms - WeChat & Alipay?

Chinese organisations, namely WeChat and Alipay, were pioneers in new payment technology that uses QR codes and in-app features to pay for goods and services. As the organisations that own WeChat and Alipay grow, so too these platforms now dominate the Chinese payment industry, with large usage nationally.

Where can I use WeChat Pay HK?

In the same year, Tencent introduced "WeChat Pay HK", a payment service for users in Hong Kong. Transactions are carried out with the Hong Kong dollar. In 2019 it was reported that Chinese users can use WeChat Pay in 25 countries outside of China, including Italy, South Africa and the UK.

How does WeChat work?

Merchants scan the code to take the payment. Users open WeChat to scan the code, confirm the amount, and make the payment after passing the security checks. Users pay for goods or services in Mini Programs created inside WeChat. Users can pay for goods and services inside the merchant's Official Account.

A WeChat account must be verified by an existing WeChat or Weixin user. To be able to verify your account, the user must meet certain conditions. The user must have: 0. Signed up to WeChat more than six ...
