VATICAN CITY (CNS) -- Pope Francis appointed two special commissioners to start work on building an agrivoltaic system on a Vatican property outside of Rome that could supply the whole of Vatican City's energy needs.

Legislative power, on the other hand, is exercised both by the Roman Pontiff and by the Pontifical Commission for Vatican City State. Finally, executive power is exercised by the Cardinal President of the Pontifical Commission for the Vatican City State, whose simplified name is President of the Governoratocurrently Msgr. Fernando Vérgez Alzaga.

Vatican City is on track to become the 8th country in the world to generate 100% of its electricity from renewable energy, following Pope Francis' announcement about plans to build a large solar plant.
