

## Xenes storage British Indian Ocean Territory

The British Indian Ocean Territory lies in the central Indian Ocean, south of the equator, at the southern end of the Chagos-Laccadive Ridge. Its central area has five atolls with islands, together with numerous other atolls and banks that are submerged to various depths, from being awash at low tide to having an upper limit of 20 m depth or more.

The British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) is an Overseas Territory of the United Kingdom situated in the Indian Ocean, halfway between Tanzania and Indonesia. The territory comprises the seven atolls of the Chagos Archipelago with over 1,000 individual islands, many very small, amounting to a total land area of 60 square kilometres (23 square ...

Collectively, the UKOTs host a permanent civilian population of approximately 250 000 (not including the British Antarctic Territory, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands, and the British Indian Ocean Territory).

The British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) is an overseas dependent territory of the United Kingdom that was established in 1965. The BIOT is comprised of six main island groups called the Chagos Archipelago.
